Bur Oak	6-8'	Large native tree with a broad crown. Fringed acorns, dark green leaves, yellow-brown fall color. Supports wildlife. Tolerant of wide soil conditions. Mature height 60-80'	\$35.00		
Red Oak	6-8'	Fast-growing native oak; rounded symmetrical habit when older. Glossy, dark green leaves have pointed lobes, turn bright red in fall. Must prune in winter. Mature height 60-80'	\$35.00		
Espresso Coffeetree	6-8'	Male selection of coffeetree that does not set fruit. No seed pods! Deer leave it alone and it has interesting scaly bark. Green foliage, golden-yellow in the fall. Mature height 50-60'	\$40.00		
River Birch (clump)	6-8'	Prefers moist soils, cinnamon-brown exfoliating bark, great yellow fall color. 3 stem clump form. Mature height 40-50'	\$35.00		
Princeton Sentry Ginko	6-8'	Pyramidal, upright shape, spreads at maturity. Seedless male variety with no fruit. Green foliage, golden in the fall. Statement tree with unique fan shaped leaves. Pest free and tolerant of urban conditions. Mature height 40-60'	\$50.00		
Ironwood	6-8'	Native hardwood tree, slender branching habit with oval head, attractive brown leaves that stay on all winter. Good for shade. Mature height 30-50'	\$45.00		
Prairifire Crabapple	6-8'	Tolerant of urban conditions, rich red flowers in spring and persistent maroon fruit in fall, excellent disease resistance. Mature height 15-20'	\$30.00		
Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry	5-6'	Ornamental tree becomes rounded with age, white flowers in spring followed by purple-black fruit. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Mature height 20-25'	\$30.00		
White Pine	24"	Fast growing, soft-needled native evergreen with long blue-green foliage. Needs moist, well-drained soil. Intolerant of salts and air pollution. Protect from deer and water at base of tree, not over the tree. Mature height 50-80'	\$30.00

American Hazelnut	2-3'	Large native shrub useful for border or natural plantings. Round ½" nuts are edible. Yellow/orange fall color. Round shape. Mature height 6-8'	\$8.00		
Common Ninebark	2-3'	Showy white flowers in the spring. Beautiful fall color. Versatile shrub with a fast growth rate. Mature height 3-10'	\$8.00		
Red Dogwood	2-3'	Fast-growing shrub with good red stem color. White flowers in late spring followed by white berries. Shade and moisture tolerant. Mature height 8-10'	\$8.00	XXXXXX	SOLD OUT
White Snowberry	2-3'	Broad, rounded shrub with blue-green leaves. Small pink flowers in June followed by persistent white fruit. Tolerates clay soils. Mature height 4-6'	\$8.00		
Meadowlark Forsythia	2-3'	Large shrub with semi-arching branches and dark green foliage. Showy yellow flowers bloom in early spring. Mature height 8-10'	\$8.00

Trees



Bur Oak 6' Tall Bare Root Height

Large native tree with a broad crown. Fringed acorns, dark green leaves, yellow-brown fall color. Supports wildlife. Tolerant of wide soil conditions. Mature height: 60-80'

Red Oak 6' Tall Bare Root Height

Fast-growing native oak; rounded symmetrical habit when older. Glossy, dark green leaves have pointed lobes, turn bright red in fall. **MUST BE PRUNED IN WINTER TO AVOID OAK WILT.** Mature height: 60-80'

Espresso Coffeetree 6' Tall Bare Root Height

Male selection of coffeetree that does not set fruit. No seed pods! Deer leave it alone and interesting scaly bark. Green foliage, golden-yellow in the fall. Mature height: 50'-60'

River Birch 6' Tall Bare Root Height (3-stem clump)

Tan-brown shaggy bark. Resistant to bronze birch borer, small seeds attractive to birds, grows well in most soils, prefers full sun, tolerates partial shade, yellow fall color. Mature height: 40-50'

Princeton Sentry Ginkgo 6' Tall Bare Root Height

Pyramidal, upright shape, spreads at maturity. Seedless male variety with no fruit. Green foliage, golden in the fall. Statement tree with unique fan shaped leaves. Pest free and tolerant of urban conditions. Mature height: 40-60'

American Ironwood 6-8' Tall Bare Root Height

Native hardwood tree, slender branching habit with oval head, attractive brown leaves that stay on all winter. Good for shade. Mature height: 30-50'

Prairifire Crabapple 5' Tall Bare Root Height

Medium size ornamental tree, upright branching, purple-red flowers in spring, bright red fruit stays on tree well into winter, attracts wildlife, very good disease resistance, medium growth rate, prefers full sunlight and well-drained soil. Mature height: 15-20'

Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry 5' Tall Bare Root Height

Ornamental tree that becomes rounded with age. White flowers bloom in abundance in spring, followed by edible, sweet, purple-black fruit. Clean summer foliage turns a brilliant red in fall. Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Mature height: 20-25'

White Pine 24" in 5 gallon pot

Fast growing, soft-needled native evergreen with long blue-green foliage. Needs moist, well-drained soil. Intolerant of salts and air pollution. Mature height: 50-80'

Shrubs

American Hazelnut 18-24" Tall Bare Root Height

Large native shrub useful for border or natural plantings. Round ½" nuts are edible. Yellow/orange fall color. Round shape. Mature height: 6-8'

Common Ninebark 2-3' Tall Bare Root Height

Arched branches with lobed leaves and showy white flowers in the spring. Five pedal flowers appear dense similar to a spirea. Versatile shrub tolerating dry and wet soils. Fast growth rate. Mature height: 3-10'

Red Dogwood 2-3' Tall Bare Root Height Fast-growing shrub with good red stem color. White flowers in late spring followed by white berries in the fall. Shade and moisture tolerant. Mature height: 8-10'

White Snowberry 2-3' Tall Bare Root Height

A broad, rounded shrub with blue-green leaves. Small pink flowers in June followed by persistent white fruit. Tolerates clay soils. Mature height: 4-6'

Meadowlark Forsythia 2-3' Tall Bare Root Height

Large shrub with semi-arching branches and dark green foliage. Showy yellow flowers bloom in early spring. Mature height: 8-10'

Please be prepared to plant!

Trees and shrubs will be ready for their new home as soon as you pick them up.
