**Common Name:** Japanese Lilac  
**Scientific Name:** *Syringa reticulata*  
**Zone:** 3  
**Light Requirements:** Sun  
**Height:** 25-30'  
**Width:** 20-25'  
**Shape:** rounded, spreading  
**Foliage Color:** dark green  
**Flower:** creamy-white  
**Fall Color:** insignificant  
**Fruit:** capsule



**Description:** Good specimen tree with an oval to rounded crown. Showy, fragrant, creamy-white flower clusters bloom in mid-June followed by a brown fruit capsule. Disease and pest-resistant.

**Common Name:** Whitespire Birch  
**Scientific Name:** *Betula populifolia* 'Whitespire'  
**Zone:** 4  
**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade  
**Height:** 40-45'  
**Width:** 30'  
**Shape:** pyramidal  
**Foliage Color:** dark green  
**Flower:** catkins  
**Fall Color:** yellow  
**Fruit:** nutlet



**Description:** An improved selection with a relaxed, pyramidal habit and chalk-white, non-exfoliating bark. Resistant to bronze birch borer, especially if heat stress is reduced.

**Common Name:** River Birch  
**Scientific Name:** *Betula nigra*  
**Zone:** 4  
**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade  
**Height:** 40-60'  
**Width:** 30-40'  
**Shape:** oval  
**Foliage Color:** dark green  
**Flower:** catkins  
**Fall Color:** yellow  
**Fruit:** nutlet

**Description:** A native pyramidal to oval headed tree with cinnamon-brown exfoliating bark. Prefers moist soils. Resistant to bronze birch borer. Susceptible to birch leaf miner, but can be controlled by spraying.

**Common Name:** Sentry American Linden  
**Scientific Name:** *Tilia americana* 'MckSentry'

**Zone:** 3

**Light Requirements:** Sun

**Height:** 60'

**Width:** 30-40'

**Shape:** pyramidal

**Foliage Color:** dark green

**Flower:** yellow

**Fall Color:** yellow

**Fruit:** nutlet

**Description:** Improved selection of American Linden that has a more upright branching habit.



**Common Name:** Sugar Maple

**Scientific Name:** *Acer saccharum*

**Zone:** 3

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 50-75'

**Width:** 40-50'

**Shape:** rounded, upright

**Foliage Color:** green

**Flower:** green-yellow

**Fall Color:** yellow-red

**Fruit:** samara

**Description:** Native tree with an upright oval-to-rounded form and brilliant yellow, orange and red fall color. Prefers rich, well-drained, slightly acidic soil. Does not tolerate drought, salt or pollution.



**Common Name:** Swamp White Oak

**Scientific Name:** *Quercus bicolor*

**Zone:** 4

**Light Requirements:** Sun

**Height:** 50-60'

**Width:** 40-50'

**Shape:** rounded

**Foliage Color:** dark green

**Flower:** insignificant

**Fall Color:** yellow

**Fruit:** acorn

**Description:** A fast-growing oak with flaky, gray-brown bark. Will tolerate drought and heavy, poorly-drained soil. Requires acidic soil. Resistant to oak wilt.



## SHRUBS

**Common Name:** American Hazelnut

**Scientific Name:** *Corylus americana*

**Zone:** 3

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 6-8'

**Width:** 6-8'

**Shape:** rounded

**Foliage Color:** dark green

**Flower:** catkins

**Fall Color:** yellow/orange

**Description:** Large native shrub useful for border or natural plantings. Round 1/2" nuts are edible. Brilliant fall color.



**Common Name:** Serviceberry

**Scientific Name:** *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Regent'

**Zone:** 2

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 4-6'

**Width:** 4-8'

**Shape:** rounded, upright

**Foliage Color:** green

**Flower:** white

**Fall Color:** yellow to red

**Description:** Large, white flowers in May followed by edible, sweet, purple-black fruit. Tolerates dry sites.



**Common Name:** Black Chokeberry

**Scientific Name:** *Aronia melanocarpa* elata

**Zone:** 3

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 4-6'

**Width:** 4-6'

**Shape:** upright, rounded

**Foliage Color:** green

**Flower:** white

**Fall Color:** red

**Description:** Ornamental shrub with glossy green foliage that turns a brilliant red in the fall. White flowers in May followed by persistent black fruit that is attractive to birds. Suckers freely and is tolerant of most soil types.



**Common Name:** Gray Dogwood

**Scientific Name:** *Cornus racemosa*

**Zone:** 3

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 10-15'

**Width:** 10-15'

**Shape:** upright, spreading

**Foliage Color:** green

**Flower:** white

**Fall Color:** purple

**Description:** Native shrub with gray bark and showy white flower clusters in mid-June followed by white berries. Red pedicels remain into late fall or early winter.



**Common Name:** Nannyberry

**Scientific Name:** *Viburnum lentago*

**Zone:** 2

**Light Requirements:** Sun/light shade

**Height:** 15-20'

**Width:** 6-10'

**Shape:** vase-shaped

**Foliage Color:** green

**Flower:** white

**Fall Color:** purple-red

**Description:** Large native shrub or small tree with slender arching branches and glossy green leaves. Blue-black fruit in fall is attractive to birds.
