



## **REDWOOD POND STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN**

Construction is scheduled to begin on September 16, 2020 at Redwood Pond, located north of the intersection of Redwood Drive and 150th St West (County Road 42) at Redwood Park. Work is scheduled to be completed by October 31, 2020.

The project includes expansion of the existing pond to the north and removal of excess sediment from the basin. This project also includes modification to the existing storm water outlet structure, realignment of the existing bituminous trail as well as removal and redesign of some existing park features impacted by pond modifications. Sediments along the north side of the pond tested for high levels of Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAHs) and require removal and disposal at a landfill that is permitted to accept this waste. Tree removal along the north and west side of the pond will be noticeable, but staff worked with the neighborhood and parks department on a tree replacement plan along with some trees being transplanted within the park.
